

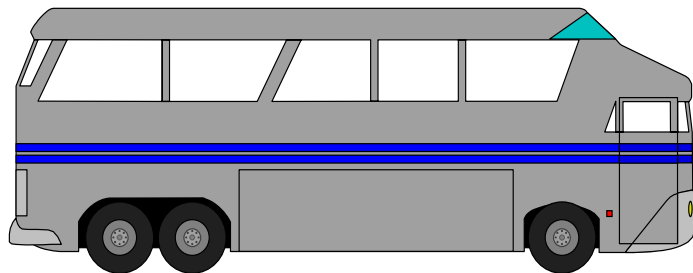

North central Wyoming, 36 miles south of the Montana border. Only 52 miles from East Gate of Yellowstone National Park (Buffalo Bill Cody Scenic Byway - U.S. Hwy. 14-16-20) and 78 miles from Northeast Gate of Yellowstone National Park (Chief Joseph Scenic Byway).

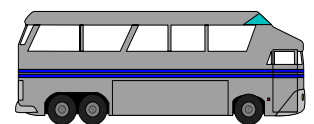

BUFFALO BILL HISTORICAL CENTER: Five separate museums housed in one facility - the Buffalo Bill Museum, Cody Firearms Museum, Whitney Gallery of Western Art, Plains Indian Museum, and the Draper Museum of Natural History. A world class facility. A MUST SEE. Group rates, allow 3+ hours. Contact: Debra Elwood, (307) 578-4114.

HISTORIC TRAIL TOWN AND MUSEUM OF THE OLD WEST: A collection of 26 authentic buildings circa mid-to-late 1800's, including Butch Cassidy's cabin from the Hole-in-the-Wall and gravesites of several notable mountain men including Jeremiah Johnson, relocated on the original town site of Cody. Seasonal, admission, allow 1 hour. Contact Clay Gibbons, (307) 587-5302.

CODY NITE RODEO: Cody is called the "Rodeo Capital of the World". Cody hosts the longest-running consecutive rodeo performances in the United States. Performances begin at 8:00 P.M. June 1 and continue nightly through August 31. Covered grandstands seat 4,000. Group discounts, allow 2 hours. Contact: Stampede Office, (307) 587-5155.

RIVER TRIPS: Cody has three companies that cater to any age group. The Shoshone River is not "whitewater" rafting, but is a beautiful float through a historic canyon with spectacular wildlife. Each company offers 3 trips daily. Group discounts, allow 2 hours for short trip.

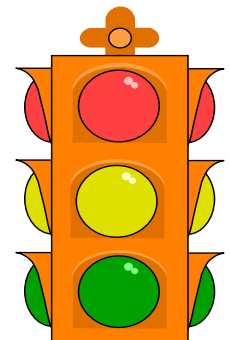
